



## VICTORIA HIGHLAND GAMES CLAN and SCOTTISH ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION

The 71st Victoria Highland Games & Celtic Festival takes place Saturday and Sunday, May 17 & 18, 2008 at its new location of Topaz **Park** in the City of Victoria.(corner of Blanshard and Finlayson Roads). This location is 3 times the size of our previous venue and is more centrally located. Participation of your Clan or Scottish organization in the Games is welcomed and very much appreciated.

The Victoria Highland Games Association is eager to enhance the Clan and Scottish organization component of this and future Games. We will again award the perpetual plaque for Best Clan Display. Clan and Scottish Organization names will also be included in the program. If you have any suggestions for further improvements, please include in your registration form.

The VHGA is pleased to provide site space and two admission passes free of charge if your clan or Scottish organization display is informational only. Tables may be ordered for a rental fee of \$10.00 each per day and chairs will be provided free of charge (the number of chairs required must be indicated on registration form). Additional admission passes may be ordered with application at a cost of \$5.00 each for Saturday and \$8.00 each for Sunday.

The Avenue of the Clans and Scottish organizations will be roughly located in the centre of Topaz Park near to the opening ceremonies area. Upon receipt of registration form and any fees, a map of the site and parking area as well as admission passes will be forwarded on to you.

### RESPONSIBILITIES DURING THE EVENT

1. Clans and Scottish organizations are expected to attend their space for the full duration of the Games.
2. Set-up time is on May 17 and 18, 2008 only from 6:30 am to 8:30 am. Vehicles are not permitted on the field and must be unloaded and parked in the lot by 8:00 am. You may park in the lot nearest the Games site; however, these spaces are provided on a first come, first serve basis. We are working towards having quads, dollies and volunteers available to help you setup.
4. You must provide your own table coverings and sun/rain protection.
5. You are responsible for removing your garbage.
6. No long term parking in loading area, vehicle must be moved once unloaded/loaded.
