

**Single Malt Whisky Tasting School**  
**72nd Victoria Highland Games & Celtic Festival**  
**May 16 & 17, 2009 at TOPAZ PARK**



The Victoria Highland Games Association is once again pleased to present its Single Malt Whisky Tasting School on May 16 and 17, 2009 at the 72<sup>nd</sup> Victoria Highland Games & Celtic Festival at Topaz Park. On each day there will be two 60-minute sessions featuring a unique line of single malts presented by the renowned Whisky Guru, Nigel Drever, and Mike Nicolson, retired distiller who both have the ultimate passion for the “Water of Life”. The interactive sessions take place right on the Games & Festival field so guests can sit down and enjoy a Scottish educational and cultural experience on the Victoria “Whisky Trail”!

The *mid day session* each day (starting at noon on Saturday and 1:15 on Sunday) will feature the Classic Malts of Scotland. The Classic Malts to be sampled will range from 10 to 16 years in age and will cover the Scottish whisky regions of the Lowlands, Highlands, Speyside, West coast, Isle of Skye and Islay. The registration fee is \$35 and includes a one-day field entry.

The *afternoon session* each day (starting at 2:00 pm on Saturday and 3:15 on Sunday) will feature the Rare Delights of Morrison Bowmore Distillers and will examine three different styles of distilling via 6 unique samples of very choice and mature single malt whiskies. The registration fee is \$35 and includes a one-day field entry.

Whisky School guests are able to buy an engraved Victoria Highland Games Glencairn whisky nosing glass for \$12 (one only per guest per class).

Each session offered is limited to 40 guests. In previous years all sessions sold out prior to the Games so don't be late requesting your registration form!

Guests must be aged 19 years or older to attend!
